## **MINUTES EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING MAY 6, 2022**

President Cory Kief called to order the Association of Levee Boards of Louisiana’s (ALBL) Executive Committee Meeting at 09:15 a.m., Friday, May 6, 2022, at the Crowne Plaza Hotel in Baton Rouge, Louisiana. There were twenty-three (23) member agencies present at the Workshop which constituted a quorum.

Cory advised that Mr. John Stringer will be retiring in June 2022 and therefore needs to be replaced as MVFCA State Executive Vice President. Motion by Mr. Keahey, to nominate Mr. Ronnie Robinson as the replacement, seconded by Mr. Bourgeois. Motion passed without opposition.

Motion by Mr. Henry, seconded by Mr. Guidry to approve the minutes of the February 11, 2022, Executive Committee Meeting. Motion passed without opposition.

The Financial Report was given by Ms. Monica Gorman who updated the budget from the last Executive Committee Meeting. The following balances formed the working capital of the ALBL: checking account \$160,447.51; and savings \$70,803.55; Litigation Savings Account \$15,904.82. The flood insurance reform coalition savings account has been closed. Motion by Ms. Chandler, seconded by Mr. Rietschier to accept the financial statement. Motion passed without opposition.

Mr. Dwayne Bourgeois gave an update on the Louisiana Flood Risk Coalition and stated that the Flood Risk Coalition account was closed and all contributing agencies will have monies returned based on the percentage of their contributions. There was a discussion on the flood insurance rate increases. Everyone was encouraged to speak to their District Attorney about this issue and urge them to take action. A special meeting to discuss in more detail may be scheduled soon.

Mr. Scott Kirkpatrick gave the Legislative Committee report and highlighted some bills of interest to the Association. Attached is the most up to date Bill Status Report.
